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Requests from the Governor of Nagano Prefecture for the Golden Week Holiday (April 19)

With the risk of infection heightened by travel, <u>Nagano Prefecture has</u> designated April 19 to May 9 a period of strengthened infection and <u>prevention control</u>.

Currently, we see increasing burdens on the medical care provision system, and **a medical care alert** is under currently effect. **COVID-19 variants*** have been found too. Please practice the following to take the utmost precautions.

*The variant viruses are highly contagious, and may be more likely to lead to serious illness. Variant viruses have seen a high rate of infection among teens or younger.

Keep in Mind

- 1. When visiting destinations or family homes outside of Nagano, talk with family and carefully consider the necessity of the trip. We ask that residents avoid travel to areas with high rates of infection* if possible.
- 2. Avoid large group meetings and meals, crowded places and **reduce other** social interactions.
- 3. Please follow **standard precautions** to prevent transmission. (Wear a mask, maintain social distancing, wash and sanitize your hands regularly, avoid the "Three Cs," etc.)
- 4. When planning large group events and activities, thoroughly restrict the number of people and take preventative measures. If sufficient precautions cannot be taken, please consider suspending or postponing plans.
